ELIGIBILITY TO APPLY

The Photographer/Videographer contract is offered through the Emerging Historians program, which provides opportunities for current students, recent graduates, or emerging professionals in the first five years of building their careers in the non-profit heritage and cultural sectors. CURRENT OPPORTUNITY

You can showcase your skills, build your portfolio, and help us promote Heritage Toronto's work. The Photographer/Videographer role is an occasional six-month contract position, beginning in May and reporting to the Manager of Marketing and Communications.

This contract position (with total value of about \$1,000) will be responsible for photography and videography of Heritage Toronto events, held throughout the year. Photographs and videos will be used by Heritage Toronto for marketing, programming, and fundraising efforts; *all use will credit the photographer/videographer by name*.

YOUR RESPONSIBILITIES

- Liaise with Manager of Marketing and Digital Media or event staff on assignments and day-of-schedules including the shot list for the program/event
- Travel to and from shoot locations
- Photograph and take videos of the event/program using contractor's own equipment
- Edit images or video into clips as necessary
- Submit photographs and videos via method determined in agreement with the Manager of Marketing and Digital Media

YOUR QUALIFICATIONS

- High degree of proficiency with a camera with 2 years of experience or training. Candidates will be asked for samples of their work
- The successful candidate must provide their own camera equipment. Heritage Toronto is not liable for any damage to this equipment
- Willing to work flexible hours, including evenings and weekends
